**(Date: 04-07-2016, Monday)**


The meeting was held on 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 from 11:30 AM onwards in the conference hall of Uttarakhand Open University, Haldwani.



The following decisions were taken unanimously:-

1. Norms and Standards for Bachelor of Education programme through Open and Distance Learning System leading to Bachelor of Education (Appendix-10 of the NCTE Regulations, 2014) were read and it was decided to run the programme as per these Norms and Standards.
2. The Course Structure and Semester wise distribution of the courses for B.Ed. ODL programme as prepared by the Expert Committee of B.Ed. programme were discussed and accepted.
3. In the beginning required number of students shall be enrolled out of 500 approved seats, in the first year in compliance of the clause 5 (b) of Appendix-10, of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 in the University headquarters and approved study centers




















from the Academic Session 2017-18. Subsequent increase in the enrollment shall be considered on the basis of the demand of the course and the availability of required infrastructural as well as instructional facilities in the Department of Teacher Education, School of Education.

4. The following syllabi for B.Ed. programme were read and discussed.
  - a. "Norms and standards for bachelor of education programme through Open and Distance Learning System leading to B.Ed. degree - Appendix-10" of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
  - b. Curriculum Framework: Two –Year B.Ed. Programme prepared by the NCTE in 2015.
  - c. Syllabus for B.Ed. Programme prepared by the NCERT in 2015.
  - d. Curriculum for 2 Year B.Ed. Programme prepared by the Department of Education, University of Delhi, New Delhi.
  - e. Syllabus for B.Ed. prepared by Faculty of Education, B.H.U.
  - f. Syllabus for B.Ed. prepared by Atal Bihari Vajpai Hindi University, Bhopal.
5. A broader framework with regard to the inclusion of appropriate and relevant contents and topics was discussed and finalized and it was decided to develop the detailed course contents for the various courses of study on the basis of the specific inputs available in the above mentioned syllabi in the context of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.
6. The Director, School of Education is authorized to prepare a comprehensive syllabus in consultation with the faculty members on the basis of the above decision of the B.O.S. This comprehensive syllabus shall be submitted to the Expert Committee Members for their consideration and approval. This approved syllabus then shall be submitted to the Members of B.O.S. for their final approval.
