c) Nature of prospective target groups of learners-




e) Instructional Design-

The program PGDCL offered by Uttarakhand Open University is a one year PG Diploma with 4 papers of 8 credits each and Viva voce of 4 credits total 36 namely:

- Intellectual property issues and Cyberspace-The Indian perspective.
- E-Commerce and Digital Evidence.
- Cyber Crimes and Consumer Protection in Cyberspace.
- Viva voce.

The University has in-house printed material available which is timely dispatched to the Study Centers for the distribution to the students, beside the printed material video Lectures facility is also available. Students have facility to clarify their doubts through E mails. Qualified Faculty is appointed to rectify the queries and doubts. Doubt clearing sessions are also organized for better understanding of syllabus.

f) Procedure for Admission, Curriculum transaction and evaluation-

Admission is available to all the graduates through online admission and direct admission both facilities are available, Fee of the course is Rs 6550. Exam are conducted in the month of December for the students enrolled in the winter session and in the month of June for the students enrolled in the summer session. Information regarding assignment, exams date Viva Voce are properly convey to the students through University Website,. Evaluation of answer sheet is done by experts of the relevant area or field.
