The Resource person Dr. Sanjay Kumar talked on the "Introduction to fuzzy set theory and its extension. In his lectures, firstly he put some quotations like:




During the second session, Dr. LN Joshi practically showed the technique of alignment using typical sticks made of silver and

Illuminating the importance of biodiversity, health care through traditional system, maintenance of water, air quality and climate stabilization were also discussed. The impact of human behaviour on biodiversity is vital, hence, the need of sustainable development was discussed to be the need of the hour.
