The meeting started with the welcome address by Prof. Durgesh Pant, Director- School of CS & IT. Following recommendations were accepted and placed in record.

- 1. The syllabus for Post Graduate Diploma in Cyber Security, developed by the expert committee of School of Computer Science & IT, was presented before the BOS for approval. After detailed deliberations, the syllabus for the Post Graduate Diploma in Cyber Security was approved by the committee. The BOS also permitted to adopt/adapt the course material provided by CEMCA for the PG Diploma in Cyber Security which is available under creative common by attribution- Sharealike license. (Appendix-I).
- 2. The syllabus for Master of Science (Information Technology) with specialization in Cyber Security, which was developed by the expert committee of School of Computer Science & IT, was presented before the BOS for approval. The syllabus was approved by the BOS. Program Coordinator- Dr. Jeetendra Pande informed the BOS that the syllabus of the above programme was developed by the expert committee in-line with the OERs available in the NPTEL website. He also sought permission from the BOS for adopting/adapting the course material for Master of Science (Information Technology) with specialization in Cyber Security programme from various Open Educational Resources(OERs), presented below in Table 1, which are available under creative common by attribution- Sharealike and creative common by attribution- Sharealike-Non-commercial license.

- 3. The BOS approved the revisions proposed by the expert committee in the course contents of Certificate in e-governance and cyber security(Appendix-III).
- 4. Currently, VISUAL BASIC is offered as a compulsory course in the second semester of Diploma in Information Technology (DIT-12) programme.

The expert committee proposed to replace Visual Basic (DIT-06) with Introduction to Computer Programming using C (Detailed syllabus is attached in Appendix IV).

The BOS approved the above revision proposed by the expert committee. The remaining courses of the DIT-12 programme shall remain unchanged.

- 5. Prof. Durgesh Pant informed the BOS that UGC have directed all the Universities to Introduce a subject "Introduction of Cyber Security/Information Security" at under graduate and post graduate level vide letter number D.O. No. 14-7/2009(CPP-II) dated 16- Jan-2013. The syllabus drafted by the expert committee for Introduction to Information Security course was presented before the BOS for approval. The BOS approved the syllabus of the above course proposed by the expert committee (Appendix V). Dr. Jeetendra Pande volunteered to develop the study material of the above course. The BOS approved the proposal of Dr. Jeetendra Pande and further recommends developing the course using OERs and also offer the course material as OER through suitable medium.
- 6. The chairmen of the BOS, Prof. Durgesh Pant raised his concern about the increasing number of reported incidents of use of plagirised material in the course material. He

further informed that to ensure the quality of the study material and deal with the issue of plagiarism, most of the reputed Universities use plagiarism detection software which highlights major source from where subject material is copied without proper referencing. He proposes to use the plagiarism detection software for ensuring the quality of the study material. The general practice for acceptance of the content is, originality of the content should equal to or greater than 80% for PhD /M.Tech /M.Phil. thesis etc.; PhD, MTech, MPhil programs are research oriented and their thesis are supposed to contains the original research inputs therefore the originality of more than 80% is required in the above cases. However, the nature of course content/study material is different from the research thesis. Study material contains the scientific principles/content etc. which are already researched by other scholars/researchers/ scientists. Therefore, use of plagiarism detection software (http://plagiarism-detector.com/) for ensuring the originality of minimum 60% or more may be considered for acceptance of the study material, which is not developed using OERs. In case the OERs are used for course development, the terms dictated in the license of the material shall prevail. The BOS accepted the above proposal and suggested the use of software like plagiarism-detector to check the originality of the contents.

7. The Director of the School, Prof. Durgesh Pant presented the list of experts before the committee for approval. He informed that the services of the above experts shall be utilised for paper setting, answer sheet evaluation, practical evaluation, project evaluation, course writing, course editing, proof reading, lecture recording, etc. or any other activity which is in the academic interest of the University. The list was approved by the BOS (The detailed list is placed as Appendix VI).

Prof. Girija Pandey, Director, School of Social Sciences and Director in-charge, School of Health Sciences welcomed all the members of the committee and briefed them about the department, the course contents and the roles and responsibilities of the Board of Studies. Thereafter detailed discussions took place amongst members and based upon these discussions the following decisions were taken unanimously:

- 1. The members of BOS consented to start Certificate Programme in Food & Nutrition (CFN) from the next academic session. The programme will be of total 16 credits. The minimum and maximum duration of the programme will be 6 months and 2 years
- 2. The minimum eligibility for admission in the programme will be 10<sup>th</sup>/Equivalent.
- 3. The syllabus and course-contents of Certificate in Food and Nutrition were discussed. Some necessary corrections and modifications were made in the syllabus already approved by members of expert committee. The PPR of the programme and corrected copy of course contents is enclosed herewith and marked as Annexure-1.
- 4. Members of the Expert Committee suggested the programme fee for Certificate in Food and Nutrition to be Rs. 1200 as it would be a socially relevant programme. The total programme fee including the exam fee is proposed to be Rs. 1800.
- 5. As suggested by the members of the expert committee that university can take some initiatives for support from Ministry of HRD, GOI about giving preference to personnel with Certificate course in Food and Nutrition working in aanganwadis and mid day meal programmes, members of BOS also supported this approach and suggested that for proper outreach of the programme proper advertisement of the programme could be initiated by the university.
- 6. Members of the Board of Studies identified and approved the names of course writers, course editors, translators, paper setters/moderators and evaluators for the development of Self Instructional Learning Material and other academic work related to Department of Home Science. A cumulative list is developed and the same is enclosed herewith as
- 7. The revised project guidelines of Diploma in Public Health and Community Nutrition (Annexure- 3) were presented before the board for approval to start dissertation work in DPHCN. The board accorded approval to start dissertation work in Diploma in Public Health and Community Nutrition. The members of the BOS suggested developing a handy pre framed manual for the project work so that it could be easy for the learners to make a project report according to the said guidelines. Members of BOS also suggested for an induction/orientation meeting for the learners for the dissertation work.
- 8. Members of BOS suggested identifying the background status of DPHCN learners. This will help the department to have an idea about the inclination of the learners of a particular background towards the programme. This will also help in need assessment of the learners and identifying the target students for the proposed programme i.e. CFN.

The meeting ended with thanks to the chair and also to all the Members of the Board.

  - b. Curriculum Framework: Two -Year B.Ed. Programme prepared by the NCTE in 2015.
  - c. Syllabus for B.Ed. Programme prepared by the NCERT in 2015.
  - d. Curriculum for 2 Year B.Ed. Programme prepared by the Department of Education, University of Delhi, New Delhi.
  - e. Syllabus for B.Ed. prepared by Faculty of Education, B.H.U.
  - f. Syllabus for B.Ed. prepared by Atal Bihari Vajpai Hindi University, Bhopal.
- 5. The following decisions were taken unanimously:-

1. Eligibility for Admission- the BOS suggested that clarification on eligibility requirement should me sought from NCTE on the following points-

a. Whether the course is only for in- service teachers trained in elementary education either from ODL or face to face mode.

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- The candidates who have completed NCTE recognized teacher education programme but are not in service are eligible.
- Clarification from NCTE will be put in next BOS. Till than for the present session candidates fulfilling provision 5 (a) (b) of NCTE, Regulation 2014 shall be eligible for the admission in B.Ed. (ODL) programme. The following categories are eligible to be students of B.Ed. (ODL) programme
  - a. Trained in-service teachers in elementary education.
  - Candidates who have completed a NCTE recognized teacher education programme through face to face mode.
- Admission Procedure applications shall be invited from the eligible candidates
  for admissions in B.Ed. (ODL) programme either in offline or online mode.
  Notification shall be made through advertisement in national newspapers and the
  University website.
  - In case more than 100 applications are received and if it is deemed necessary then an entrance test will be conducted for selecting prospective 50 students.
  - In case the number of applications is less than 100 then the selection shall be made on the basis of merit of academic and teaching experience.
  - In case 02 or more students attain equal marks in entrance test or merit of academicst & teaching experience than merit position shall be decided on the basis of seniority in age.
  - In case if the tie continues then percentage marks at graduation level will be taken into consideration.

The following two criteria will be adopted depending upon the situation.

a. Entrance Test -The entrance test shall consist of following three sections-

- 5. The BOS decided that School Internship- CPS 19 in 3rd semester, of 12 credit and total 300 marks be divided into two parts. It will have an external assessment.
  - a. Part I of 150 marks marks shall be provided on the basis of feedback given on lesson plans and criticism book submitted.
  - Part II- a viva voce of 150 marks
- 6. The BOS decided that in Semester IV EPC-2, EPC-3 and EPC- 4 courses will have an external assessment based on practical work and activity of 50 marks each.
- 7. The students will have to attend a mandatory workshop of 6 days each in Semester I and Semester III.
- 8. The BOS also decided that as per the policy of the University weightage to assignments should be changed to 20 marks.
- 9. Eligibility for a study centre to run B.Ed. ODL programme has been mentioned in the NCTE Regulations. 2014, Appendix 10-5[(a) (b) (c) (d) (e)].

The BOS decided that the matter should be referred to RSD to identify the eligible study centre so that necessary action may be taken. However, as per the provision 5(b)(iii) of the NCTE, Regulations, 2014 the Headquarters or the Regional Centre of the ODL institution may also function as a Study Centre at least

for 100 (50 first year and 50 second year) students.

10. The BOS minutely revised the programme structure. The revised programme structure is being attached, duly signed by the members of BOS.
