Regulations (Conditions of Play)

This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes, General Competition Regulations (GCR), Para Badminton General Competition Regulations (PBGCR) and BWF Para Badminton World Championships Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final.

This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in the BWF PBGCR. This includes restrictions of certain colors for shirts, shorts, and skirts to avoid issues with virtual advertising on TV courts, as per GCR 21.7.

The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into any accredited venue or area or service (e.g. transportation) as a result of damaged or missing accreditation. The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, and penalties being applied. Medical Services A medical officer and physiotherapist service will be available during the tournament, free of charge to players. **Anti-Doping** Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted outof-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches. This means that every player participating must complete an anti-doping education course before they arrive in Tokyo for the Championships. This is a mandatory requirement in order to compete at the HULIC DAIHATSU BWF Para Badminton World Championships 2022.

4. Airport Transfer, Visa, and Hotel Accommodation

Transportation (Airport Transfer)

Complimentary transportation will be provided by the tournament between the following official venues:

Competition venue - Official hotel (Grand Nikko Tokyo Daiba) - Practice venue (if separate from the competition venue) - Tokyo International Airport (Haneda - HND)

Entry Date Requirements

Entry into Japan for participants

Entry date for participants depends on if the participants are required to undergo organisational quarantine/government facility quarantine.

The quarantine restriction for the tournament has been significantly reduced and mainly affects participants who are arriving from regions classified as yellow and red in accordance with the Japan Government. Please see link for the classification of regions LINK. Do check the link regularly as the regions might change subject to the pandemic situation around the world

The following group of participants DO NOT require to undergo organisational quarantine and is recommended to arrive on 29 or 30 October 2022

 a) If arriving from <u>BLUE</u> regions within 14 days of departure to Japan regardless of vaccinated status.

No on-arrival test and quarantine. (Upon entry to Japan, no restrictions of movement, allowed to take public transport, dine out at food establishment, buy groceries etc).

b) If arriving from YELLOW regions within 14 days of departure to Japan and vaccinated with booster of specific vaccines.

No quarantine will apply if one is fully vaccinated with specific vaccine and boosted with specific vaccine Upon entry to Japan, no restrictions of movement, allowed to take public transport, dine out at food establishment, buy groceries etc

The following group of participants MUST undergo organisational quarantine should arrive by 26th October.

a) Arriving from YELLOW regions within 14 days of departure to Japan and DID NOT RECEIVE the specific 3 doses of vaccine.

The participant will then have to do an organizational quarantine. Day 0 being arrival



day on 26 Oct Aug. Participants may take a covid test on third day of quarantine on 29 Oct and be discharged if test negative. You will have to go through 5 days of quarantine if you do not take the test.

Upon discharge from quarantine, there will not be any further restrictions of movement. The organisational quarantine will be done at the official hotel. During the organisational quarantine, one must stay in the room at all times including having all meals in the room. Meals have to ordered via hotel room service only.

b) Arriving from RED regions within 14 days of departure to Japan and received the specific 3 doses of vaccine. The participant will then have to do 4 days of organisational quarantine.

The participant will then have to do an organizational quarantine. Day 0 being arrival day on 26 Oct Aug. Participants may take a covid test on third day of quarantine on 29 Oct and be discharged if test negative. You will have to go through 5 days of quarantine if you do not take the test.

The organisational quarantine will be done at the official hotel. During the organisational quarantine, one must stay in the room at all times including having all meals in the room. Meals have to ordered via hotel room service only.

The following group of participants will have to do quarantine at specific government quarantine facilities and is recommended to arrive into Tokyo on 26th October 2022.

c) Arriving from RED regions within 14 days of departure to Japan and DID NOT RECEIVE the specific 3 doses of vaccine. The participant will then have to do 4 days of quarantine at Government Facility.

Countries currently on the list as RED are Albania and Sierra Leone

The participant will then have to do an organizational quarantine. Participant will be sent to the government facility from the airport directly. Day 0 being arrival day on 26 Oct Aug. Participants may take a covid test on third day of quarantine on 29 Oct and be discharged if test negative.

During quarantine, one must stay in the room at all times including having all meals in the room. Meals will be provided. Upon discharge from quarantine, participant can process to check into the official hotel on 29 or 30 Oct 2022. Participants will be subjected to on-arrival test at the airport and daily test during the quarantine. Upon discharge from quarantine, there will not be any further restrictions of movement.

Vaccines accepted

For specific vaccines, please read the following <u>LINK</u>. There are fewer specific vaccines for the 3rd dose. In order to be considered fully vaccinated, one must have 3 doses of vaccines listed on the specific vaccines list

Visa

As of 20 July, 2022, all foreign nationals who wish to newly enter Japan need to apply for a visa except for those with re-entry permit.

- Certificate for completion of registration to the ERFS system (*)
- Invitation letter
- Letter of guarantee
- Schedule of stay (Itinerary in Japan)
- Details of inviting (receiving) company/organization

*Based on New Border Measures, foreign nationals who apply for new entry into Japan are regarded as those with "special exceptional circumstances" and are allowed for new entry into Japan in principle, if the receiving organizations located in Japan complete prescribed applications in the Entrants, Returnees Follow-up System (ERFS).

Therefore, besides the documents normally required, an ERFS certificate must also be submitted.

Please complete and return the Application Form (for Airport Transfer, Visa, and Hotel Accommodation) by 15 September along with each member's passport copy.

The official travel agency will prepare the above 5 documents in PDF files and email them to the person in charge on behalf of the tournament organizer. The support documents shall be provided only if the form is completed accurately and comprehensively.

In addition to the above 5 support documents, an applicant must fill out and submit a visa application form with a photo attached.
