The event was a collaborative initiative by the School of Management Studies and Commerce, Placement Cell, and Centre for Internal Quality Assurance (CIQA). The workshop aimed to provide valuable insights into leveraging virtual platforms for effective career counseling and professional growth. The program began with Dr. Akhilesh Singh's warm welcome, who set a positive tone for the event by addressing the significance of career planning in today's rapidly evolving professional phase.

Following the welcome note, Prof. Girija Pandey, Director of CIQA, provided a concise yet impactful introduction to the workshop. 
METHODOLOGY


Analysis of Learners' Feedback










Summary of the analysis of Learners' feedback about Career counseling:

In the academic session 2023-24, input from various learners enrolled in different subjects was analyzed, with a sample of 55 learners providing their insights. Regarding the content delivery

by the expert among the 55 learners 43.6% found it excellent. When asked about the expert lecture 52.7% found it excellent. Regarding the communication skills of the expert, 52.7% of them found it excellent. About rating the overall session 43.6% of learners found it excellent. When asked about the expert's engagement with the learners in the session 58.2% of them found it very engaging whereas 27.3% of them had neutral responses.

When reflecting on their overall experience, learners provided positive responses with several offering suggestions for improvement. The department has taken these suggestions seriously and carefully considered the recommendations. Faculty members are committed to improving and enhancing further while conducting career counseling.
