Guidelines and list of supervisors for M.Sc. (Botany) dissertation work (Session January, 2025)

Uttarakhand Open University, Haldwani

During the course of study, all the learners (M.Sc. Botany IV Semester, January 2025) have to do a compulsory short term research and submit a dissertation for partial fulfillment of the requirement of the M. Sc. degree. University offers number of themes for M. Sc. dissertation from which a learner can select a research topic under the guidance of allotted supervisor. Different themes for M.Sc. research are proposed by the concerned departments which are as follows:

- Plant Biodiversity and Conservation
- Ethnobotany and Medicinal Plants
- Molecular Biology and Biotechnology
- Microbiology and Applied Botany
- Plant Resource Utilization
- Plant Ecology
- Economic Botany
- Plant Taxonomy

Procedure for allotment of supervisors:

Learners can contact the supervisors allotted by the university for the successful completion of dissertation work (list attached).

- **Topic selection criteria:** Topic should be related to assigned themes of the dissertation work.
- **Synopsis must contain:** Synopsis should be of 3-5 pages. The standard font should be Times New Roman of 12 pts with 1.5 line spacing. Synopsis must signed by learner and supervisor(s).

After finalizing the topic the learners have to submit soft copy of synopsis, approved and duly signed by the supervisor to the mail id: dob@uou.ac.in within 15 days after publishing the guidelines in the university website

*Note: After completion of the dissertation work, learners have to submit the hard copy of dissertation (approved and duly signed by the supervisor) by post in favour of "Coordinator, Department of Botany, Uttarakhand Open University, behind Transport Nagar, Teenpani Bypass Road, Haldwani, 263 139, District Nainital" and soft copy of dissertation (approved and duly signed by the supervisor) should be sent to the mail id: dob@uou.ac.in on 31August, 2025

GUIDELINES FOR SYNOPSIS

Synopsis should be summary of the study with significant findings that emphasize the original contributions in the submitted dissertation. After choosing the topic of the dissertation (themes allotted by university), use the following standards and structure to submit the synopsis.

- 1. Title of the Dissertation/Topic
- 2. **Introduction:** must include background of proposed study, statement of problem and objectives.
- 3. **Review of literature:** Highlights of already published work on the given topic.
- 4. **Materials and methods**: Explains methods, tools & technique, materials required, etc. for the study.
- 5. **References:** Cited literatures
- **Topic selection criteria:** Topic should be related to assigned themes of the dissertation work (attached in University website, Announcement).
- **Synopsis must contain:** Synopsis should be of 3-5 pages. The standard font should be Times New Roman of 12 pts with 1.5 line spacing.
- After finalizing the topic the learners have to submit soft copy of synopsis, approved and duly signed by the supervisor to the mail id: dob@uou.ac.in

GUIDELINES FOR DISSERTATION

The dissertation should be presented in a number of chapters, starting with Introduction and ending with Summary and Conclusions. Each of the other chapters will have a precise title reflecting the contents of the chapter. A chapter can be subdivided into sections and subsection so as to present the content discretely and with due emphasis.

Chapter 1: Introduction:

The title of Chapter 1 shall be Introduction. It shall justify and highlight the problem posed, define the topic and explain the aim and scope of the work presented in the dissertation. It may also highlight the significant contributions from the investigation.

Chapter 2: Review of Literature:

This shall normally form Chapter 2 and shall present a critical appraisal of the previous

work published in the literature pertaining to the topic of the investigation.

Chapter 3: Material and Methods:

This chapter deals with a detail methodology by which used to collect/ synthesize the data.

Chapter 4: Results and Discussions:

This shall form the penultimate chapter of the dissertation and shall include a thorough evaluation of the investigation carried out and bring out the contributions from the study. The discussion shall logically lead to inferences and conclusions as well as scope for possible further future work.

Chapter 5: Summary and Conclusions:

This will be the final chapter of the dissertation. A brief report of the work carried out shall form the first part of the Chapter. Conclusions derived from the logical analysis presented in the results and discussions chapter shall be presented and clearly enumerated, each point stated separately. Scope for future work should be stated lucidly in the last part of the chapter.

Chapter 6: References/Bibliography:

The candidates shall follow the style of citation and style of listing in one of the standard journals in the subject area consistently throughout his/her dissertation (mentioned below). However, the names of all the authors along with their initials and the full title of the article/monogram/book etc. have to be given in addition to the journals/publishers, volume, number, pages(s) and year of publication. Citation from websites should include the names(s) of author(s) (including the initials), full title of the article, website reference and when last accessed. Reference to personal communications, similarly, shall include the author, title of the communication (if any) and date of receipt. The example is given below:

For journal:

For book:

Chauhan NS (1999) Medicinal and Aromatic Plants of Himachal Pradesh. Indus Publishing Company, New Delhi.

For Chapter in book:

Chapter 7: Appendix:

• Detailed information, lengthy derivations, raw experimental observations etc. are to be presented in the separate appendices, which shall be numbered in Roman

Capitals (e.g. "Appendix IV").

- Submit the Plagiarism report (Any available plagiarism software) of the dissertation
- Please bind a copy of synopsis after the plagiarism report.

Type -Setting, Text Processing and Printing

The text shall be printed employing using a standard text processor. The standard font shall be Times New Roman of 12 pts with 1.5 line spacing.

Auxiliary

- 1. Binding: Hard Binding
- **2. Front Covers:** The front covers shall contain the following details:
 - Full title of thesis in 22 point's size font properly centered and positioned at top.
 - Full name of the candidate in 15 point's size font properly centered at the middle of the page.
 - Do not use University emblem (university logo) on the dissertation or synopsis.
- **3. Blank Sheets:** In addition to the white sheets (binding requirement) two white sheets shall be put at the beginning and the end of the dissertation.
- **4. Title Sheet:** This shall be the first printed page of the thesis and shall contain the submission statement: the dissertation submitted in partial fulfillment of the requirements of the Degree e.g. M.Sc., the name and enrollment No. of the candidate, name(s) of the Supervisor and Co- supervisor (s) (if any), Department, University and year of submission. Sample copy of the 'Title Sheet' is enclosed (Annexure I)
- **5. Dedication:** Sheet If the candidate so desires(s) he may dedicate his/her dissertation, which statement shall follow the title page. If included, this shall form the page 1 of the auxiliary sheets but shall not have a page number.
- **6.** A Declaration of Academic Honesty and Integrity by Candidate: A declaration of Academic honesty and integrity is required to be included along with every thesis/dissertation after the Supervisor's certificate. The format of this declaration is given in Annexure `II' attached.
- 7. Certificate from Candidate and Supervisor (Annexure 'III'):
- **8. Abstract:** The 500 word (maximum) abstract shall highlight the important features of the dissertation. The abstract in the dissertation, however, shall have two more parts, namely, the layout of the dissertation giving a brief chapter- wise description of the work and the key words.
- **9. Contents:** The contents shall follow the abstract and shall enlist the titles of the chapters, section and sub-section using decimal notation, as in the text, with corresponding page number against them, flushed to the right. Two separate lists of figure captions and table titles along with their numbers and corresponding page numbers against them shall

follow the contents.

10. Abbreviation Notation and Nomenclature: A complete and comprehensive list of all abbreviations, notations and nomenclature including Greek alphabets with subscripts and superscripts shall be provided after the list of tables and figures.




