PART I: BASIC STEPS TO REGISTER FOR THE PROGRAMME

Step 1: Visit the NIEPA Website

Open the official NIEPA website: niepa.ac.in

Step 2: Open the NIEPA MMTTC Section

From the home page, select the NIEPA MMTTC tab.

Step 3: Select the Programme

A table of available programmes will appear.

From the table, identify and select the aforementioned NEP Orientation and Sensitisation Programme.

Then click on the “Register Here” option.

Step 4: Login

Login using your UGC MMTTC login credentials.

After successful login, proceed with the registration process as explained below specifically for the NEP Sensitisation Programme.

PART II: SPECIFIC STEPS TO JOIN THE NEP SENSITISATION PROGRAMME

For those specifically intending to join the NEP Sensitisation Programme, please follow the steps given below carefully.

Step 1: Login to the UGC MMTTC Portal

Login to the UGC MMTTC portal using your participant credentials.

Step 2: Open the Dashboard

After login, the Home Page/Dashboard will appear.

On the left-hand side of the dashboard, look for the section titled:

“Apply for NEP Theme Training”

Open this section.

Step 3: Select the Centre

In the relevant search fields:

- Under Centre, choose NIEPA.
- Under Month, choose September.
- Under State of MMTTC Centre, choose Delhi.

Step 4: Click on Search

After selecting the above-mentioned options, click on “Search.”

A new table containing the relevant training programme will appear.

Step 5: Select the Correct Training Programme

From the newly displayed table, select the following programme:

Training Programme ID: MMC-018-2026-SEP-A-08317

Please ensure that the Training Programme ID is correctly selected.

Step 6: Click on Participate

After selecting the programme, click on the “Participate” option.

Step 7: Upload the Nomination Letter

You will then be required to upload a duly filled and signed nomination letter from your respective Department Head.

Please ensure that the nomination letter is properly completed and duly signed before uploading it.

Step 8: Upload and Participate

After uploading the duly filled and signed nomination letter, complete the participation process by submitting the required details.

A sample nomination letter is attached/provided in the same window, which can be easily downloaded and used for the purpose of completing the nomination process.

PART III: IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A UGC MMTTC LOGIN

If you do not already have a login account on the UGC MMTTC portal, please follow the steps given below to create your account.

Step 1: Open the UGC MMTTC Portal

Visit: mmc.ugc.ac.in

Step 2: Select “Register Now”

On the portal, select the “Register Now” option.

Step 3: Complete the Participant Registration Form

Fill in the required details in the Participant Registration Form carefully.

After entering all the required information, submit the registration form.

Step 4: Start the Login Process

Once your registration has been completed, use the details created during the registration process to begin the login procedure.

At the time of login:

First, choose your role as “Participant”.

Then proceed with the login using your registered credentials.

PART IV: COMPLETION OF PROFILE AFTER LOGIN

After successful login, the Home Page/Dashboard will appear.

Step 1: Open the Profile Section

Go to the Profile section available on the dashboard.

Step 2: Complete Your Profile

Complete all the required information in your profile carefully and accurately.

Step 3: Upload Employee ID / Appropriate Document

In the Employee ID Card section:

- Scholars may upload their Institute/University ID Card.
- Faculty members who do not have an ID Card may upload their Joining Letter.

Please ensure that the document uploaded is clear and readable.

Step 4: Submit Your Profile

After completing all the required information and uploading the relevant document, submit the Profile section.

Once the profile has been successfully completed and submitted, you can proceed to apply for the available programmes.
